

PRIMARY SCHOOL ONLINE LEARNING PROGRAMME

- Class teachers are available LIVE through Microsoft Teams (MT) between 8.00 am, and 8.30 am to talk through an introduction to the day.
- All children will log on for 8.00 am so that attendance can be taken and learning questions can be answered with the whole class present. This will avoid repetition and one-to-one interactions in line with our child protection policy. The teacher will remain online through video during this time.
- It is expected that a parent, guardian or an appropriate adult is present or in close proximity during any live interaction; otherwise, pupils should not join the meeting.
- The core subjects of English and Maths are delivered live every day. In week 5, we are using ZOOM to support live interaction further, but only through the embedded version in Teams.
- For other subjects, teachers can create a video demonstration and / or introduction for each lesson/subject if they are timed lessons. To give flexibility, lessons are uploaded so they can be accessed throughout the day. If videos are used, they will be between 5 – 10 minutes maximum in length. They will give the child an overview of the learning and expected outcomes.
- Live PE takes place for the whole of primary at 11 am every day to enable families to get involved together
- Live library read-ins also take place every day
- Tasks will be completed throughout the course of the day as they would be in a typical lesson, whilst others will take the form of more extended projects over the course of the week.
- No extra homework will be set during this period of online learning. It remains our expectation that children will continue to read over the two weeks of distance learning.
- Work will be submitted in line with the instructions of the class teacher, i.e. through MT, photographs of work, video blogs of work or project work submitted on return to actual school.
- In the case of pupil work submitted, teachers will mark and return online where possible.
- Staff are available online between 8.00 am and 2.30 pm daily (8.00 am-1.00 pm on Thurs) should parents need to contact them. Outside of these hours, please understand that queries may not be addressed until the following day.
- Each week a lesson will be planned in each of the specialist areas (Art, Music and PE for Years 1 and 2 with Coding, DT, Drama as appropriate to higher year groups).

- These will be uploaded at the beginning of the week and will be project-based which the pupils can access on any day.
